Members should be chosen primarily based on their knowledge of an aspect of the thesis and their ability to give helpful advice. The Program in Neuroscience's requirements for committee selection and meetings are as follows:

- The Dissertation Committee consists of 5 voting members who hold a doctoral degree, inclusive of your research mentor and 1 external faculty member.
- Up to 7 members are allowed but this is highly discouraged due to scheduling challenges.
- At least three members must be <u>PIN Faculty</u> (including mentor).

- The external member must be selected from outside of the program, department, or discipline, and, preferably, be external to the University itself.
- Students must meet with the Committee on regular intervals (minimum of once annually; updates must be provided every 6 months) to assess progress.
